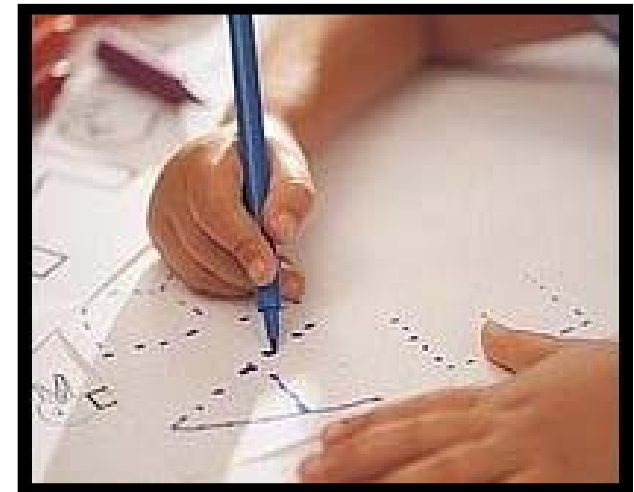

## Crab Grabbers

Designed for children ages 4-5 years old, **Crab Grabbers** addresses foundation skills needed for good penmanship. The focus will be hand and fine motor development, shape and directional line concepts, and basic strokes that are the building blocks for writing in kindergarten as well as the early primary grades. This group of children are often currently practicing with single letters or basic words. All children this age would enjoy the fun multisensory approach to activities. Participants should be able to communicate, follow directions in a small group setting, and need to be able to work both independently as well as with others. A Fine Motor Take Home Kit is provided on the last day allowing families to easily practice similar hand development activities, long after the camp is finished.

## Print Wizards

**Print Wizards** is intended for children in the early primary grades who need help fine-tuning their penmanship skills using manuscript. Children in this group are often currently practicing with writing at a phrase, sentence, or small paragraph level. A complete review of letter sequences within writing lines will remediate common difficulties such as spacing and legibility errors, poor letter formation, and letter reversals. Small motor development activities will promote successful pencil grasp and motion when writing. We will use a multisensory approach to make handwriting FUN! Participants should be able to communicate, follow directions in a small group setting, and need to be able to work both independently as well as with others. Upon admission to the group, parents will be asked to complete a short questionnaire plus guide their child through a handwriting sample at home to help identify areas of concern.
