



## INDIVIDUAL OPPORTUNITIES

**2015 Walk and Roll for KIDS-** this event takes place May 16, 2015. Individual volunteers needed to form teams within corporations, civic groups, churches, schools, and more. Event named because some of our clients “walk” and some of them “roll”. Some teams formed around a person with a disability. Volunteers also needed for overall event committee to help plan the event. Extensive volunteer needs for day of the event.

**2014 Holiday Fashion Show** – planning team for this wonderful special event where over 80 of our children model clothes on stage. People with event experience, or just passion for our mission should apply.

**2014 MEET THE KIDS Ambassador**– volunteers go through training on identifying potential contacts. Volunteers invite guests to free, twice monthly educational tours. Tours are not a solicitation. Goal is to network. Expected to choose one tour during the year and invite 5-10 people to come tour with you.

**2014 Table Host for Champions Breakfast** – volunteers host a table of 10 for this free one hour fundraiser. Volunteers undergo brief training, participate in our tour program, and invite guests to join them for the Champions for Kids breakfast in early December each year.

**2015 Mini & Marathon Team** – join “Team Ability” and raise money while training for the race. Many resources provided to team members, such as clinics, free team shirt, website to raise funds, and more. Also still need a few more people for the committee planning this team effort. **Marketing and PR Committee-** this group helps build community awareness and involvement in our work. Our goal is to turn this 50 year old best kept secret into a locally recognized treasure. Do not need to have professional marketing as a job, though it is a definite advantage.
